

Great Smoky Mountains, Biltmore Estate, Grand Ole Opry Nashville, TN



9 days - 8 nights departing Wednesday May 17 2017

A superb tour as we travel to Kentucky, North Carolina, the Great Smoky Mountains and Tennessee. The tour culminates in Nashville with a visit to the Grand Ole Opry, Country Music Capital of the World.



Travel Itinerary

Day 1: Fly from Rapid City to Louisville, KY

Today we meet at Rapid City Regional Airport for our flight to Louisville, KY. On arrival, we are met in the baggage hall by our driver and transferred to our hotel.

Day 2: Louisville to Renfro Valley via Churchill Downs (130 miles)

After breakfast we visit Churchill Downs and our tour of this museum and race facility is a wonderful experience. After our tour we depart for Renfro Valley. Renfro Valley is known

as "Kentucky's Country Music Capital," a title the little town can easily lay claim to. This evening, it's time for the Renfro Valley Barn Dance The show that started it all... traditional country, Bluegrass & Comedy.

Day 3: Renfro Valley, KY to Inn on Biltmore Estate, Asheville NC (235 miles)

After an early breakfast it's time to leave for North Carolina and the amazing 8,000 acre Biltmore Estate Here we are inspired by the relaxed elegance of George and Edith Vanderbilt's 250-room family home and country retreat in Asheville, NC.

Discover original art from masters such as Renoir, magnificent 16th-century tapestries, Napoleon's chess set, a library with 10,000 volumes, a Banquet

Hall with a 70-foot ceiling, 65 fireplaces, an indoor pool, bowling alley, and priceless antiques.

This French Renaissance Chateau remains America's largest privately owned home.

Day 4: Asheville, NC to Pigeon Forge (93 miles scenic drive via The Great Smoky Mountains)

Enjoy the magnificent scenery as we travel through the Smoky

Mountains. Ridge upon ridge of forest straddles the border between North Carolina and Tennessee in Great Smoky Mountains National Park. World renowned for its diversity of plant and animal life, the beauty of its ancient mountains and the quality of its remnants of Southern Appalachian mountain culture.

Arriving into Pigeon Forge is which is our home for the next three nights.



This evening we enjoy a delicious supper followed by Country Tonite, the hottest, foot stompin', knee slappin' country show in the USA!

Day 5: Pigeon Forge / Gatlinburg

Today we step back in time and explore Cades Cove. For hundreds of years Cherokee Indians hunted in Cades Cove but archeologists have found no evidence of major settlements. The first Europeans

settled in the cove sometime between 1818 and 1821. By 1830 the population of the area had already swelled to 271.

Cades Cove offers the widest variety of historic buildings of any area in the national park. Scattered along the loop road are three churches, a working grist mill, barns, log houses, and many other faithfully restored eighteenth and nineteenth century structures.

Afterwards we have time to explore the many shops & sights of Gatlinburg before supper & show.

Day 6: Pigeon Forge & Dollywood

Today prepare to be entertained by all that Dollywood offers. Take in this great venue at your own pace.
